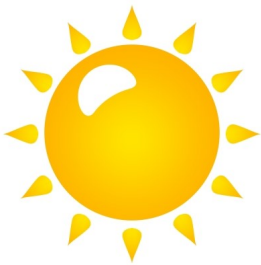

by putting in the correct weather term?

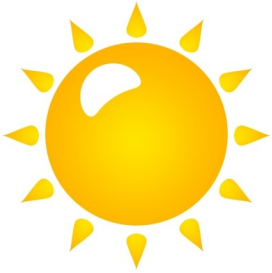
